

# The Statute of Westminster

... THE Crown is the symbol of the free association of the members of The British Commonwealth of Nations ... no law hereafter made by the Parliament of the United Kingdom shall extend to any of the said Dominions ... otherwise than at the request and with the consent of that Dominion and ... it is hereby declared and enacted that the Parliament of a Dominion has full power to make laws ...
