Listed below are the events that occurred in July/August 1914 immediately following the assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand. Arrange them in chronological order using the information contained within the slideshow.

- ____. Austro-Hungary declares war on Serbia
- ____. The Serbian government appeals to Russia for help against the proposed attack by the Austro-Hungarian army.
- ____. Germany declares war on France
- ____. Britain defends her 1839 treaty to protect Belgium and declares war on Germany.
- ____. Assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand
- ____. Russia promises to help Serbia if it is attacked by Austro-Hungarian forces
- ____. Germany marches into Belgium
- ____. Russia mobilizes its armed forces in support of Serbia. This includes the sending of troops to its borders with Germany and Austria-Hungary
- ____. The German government announces its full support for Austria-Hungary if it decides to take reprisals against Serbia
- ____. The Austro-Hungarian government makes fifteen demands on the Serbian government (sends an ultimatum) in the wake of the archduke's assassination
- ____. Germany declares war on Russia
